**ELIGIBILITY and TEST REQUIREMENTS:** Singles: Excel and Well-Balanced Events:

- Skaters must meet at least the minimum singles test requirements for the event's level. A skater's singles test level may be higher than the minimum requirement.

- Skate Up: skaters may skate up one level higher than their minimum test requirement allows.

- Skaters may not register for an event level lower than allowed by their competitive floor. An athlete's competitive floor is set by one of the following scenarios:

- Skaters are not permitted to enter an Excel free skate and a Well-Balanced free skate event at the same competition (example: Juvenile Girls Free Skate and Juvenile Girls Excel Free Skate). However, they are permitted to enter an Excel and a Well-Balanced event of different types such as a short program (if stand-alone event option), specialty or showcase events (example: Intermediate Women Short Program and Intermediate Women Excel Free Skate).

All other singles and partner events (such as Adults, Pairs, Ice Dance):

- Skaters must meet the minimum test requirements for the events level, but not exceed the maximum permissible test requirement.

**ENTRIES AND FEES:** All competitors must register on-line at [www.entryeeze.com](http://www.entryeeze.com). Please be sure to enter your coach's correct email address as he/she will receive a list of his/her competitors and is required to verify that the skaters are entered in the correct level/event. **DEADLINE for entry** is no later than 11:59pm on **Monday, October 6, 2024**. No late entries will be accepted. The entry fee for the first event is \$90 (includes free video download of performance) and \$45 (includes free video download of performance) for each additional event.

**REFUND POLICY: From the rulebook - 3055** At nonqualifying competitions, if only one eligible competitor/team enters an event, the competitor/team will be offered the option to skate an exhibition, compete in an equivalent event one level above or one level below (as qualified by test level) or, for pre-juvenile and lower and adult bronze and lower singles events, compete in an equivalent event against skaters of the opposite gender. If said competitor/team chooses not to skate, the entry fee will be refunded, and the event will be cancelled. There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals. The online processing fees are not refundable.

**LIABILITY:** U.S. Figure Skating, Jersey Coast FSC, club, organizers of this competition, Jersey Shore Arena, its management and employees undertake no responsibility for damage or injuries suffered by the skaters or officials. As a condition of and in consideration of the acceptance of their entries or participation therein, all entrants, their parents or guardians and officials shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injury to their person and property resulting from, caused by, or connected with, the conduct and management of this competition, and to waive and release any and all claims which they have against its officers and trustees, and their entries shall be accepted only on such condition.

**COACHES: You must verify your skater's event and level by 11:59pm on October 7, 2024.** No changes in events or levels will be made after October 7<sup>th</sup>.

### **INFORMATION REGARDING COACHES:**

To be an eligible coach at a nonqualifying competition, coaches must meet the applicable compliance requirements and verified by U.S. Figure Skating. Coach compliance falls into two categories, Coach Compliance (includes choreographers) and Learn to Skate USA® Instructor Compliance. All compliance requirements must be met at the time of check-in to access the competition, no exceptions

**AWARDS:** All events will be final rounds. Medals will be awarded to first, second, third, and fourth places. ALL awards will be made at approximately 30 minute intervals throughout the competition.

**SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:** Will be posted on the website [www.entryeeze.com](http://www.entryeeze.com) approximately one week prior to the competition. You will receive an email containing the date and time of your specific events. It is highly recommended that skaters arrive 1 hour prior to their scheduled event.

**PRACTICE ICE:** Practice ice will be available during our regularly scheduled freestyle sessions. (Check rink freestyle calendar for exact times. [www.jerseyshorearena.com](http://www.jerseyshorearena.com)). A 30 minute practice session may be purchased at the rink for \$12.

**REGISTRATION:** The registration desk will open one hour prior to the competition.

**MUSIC:** Competition **music** must be **submitted electronically via the on-line registration system Entryeeze by 11:59pm on Friday, October 17, 2025**. A late fee of \$25.00 per event will be charged to any competitor that fails to submit their music prior to the deadline, submits files that are mp3 or mp4 format, or uploads incorrect music. The late fee must be paid in cash, at the time of registration check-in at the event. Competitor will not receive event credentials until the fee is paid.

After you have paid for your events, the online system will prompt you to upload your music for each event that requires music. If your music is not available at that time, you can logout of your account and return later to upload your music by going to the "competition" tab and then selecting "my music".

**VIDEO TAPING AND PHOTOGRAPHS:** An official competition videographer will be filming all performances. A digital download of each skater's performance will be sent by the photographer after the competition. **Flash** photography is **not** permitted during competition events or warm-ups for the safety of the skaters.
